Training on "Copyright and Plagiarism"

On February 27, 2025, a training session on "Copyright and Plagiarism" was conducted by Raziya Isayeva, Dean of the School of Economics and Management at Khazar University, within the framework of the ERASMUS+DIRNA project, where Khazar University serves as the coordinator.

The training concluded with discussions around the subject matter.









Copyright Transfer Agreements (CTA) and Publishing

- What is a Copyright Transfer Agreement (CTA)?
 - o When researchers publish in academic journals, they often transfer some or all of their copyright to the
 - o Different types of agreements (exclusive vs. non-exclusive licenses).
- What Rights Do You Lose by Signing a CTA?
 - o The right to share the final published version.
 - o The ability to reuse content in future work.
- Retaining Rights When Publishing:
 - Negotiating contract terms with publishers.
 - o Choosing publishers that allow open access and self-archiving.
- Institutional Open Access Policies:
 - o Many universities and funders require research to be openly accessible (e.g., Plan S in Europe).
 - Self-archiving in institutional repositories.
